Description: The proposed project is a 32 lot single family residential development on a 139.77 acre parcel in Sections 5 and 6, Twp 33N, Rg 27W, Big Lake Township, Sherburne County, Minnesota. The minimum lot size is 2.5 acres with individual wells, on-site septic systems and public roadways. ### Glacier Resources

Description: Glacier Resources, Incorporated proposes to mine gravel on 78.57 acres of land located within a 186.38 acre tract. Existing topsoil will be removed and stockpiled for reclamation upon project completion. A payloador and dozer will load material into a primary loading facility where it will be transferred onto an overland conveyor system and conveyed to the main plant for final processing. Plans are to leave 10-15 feet of material above ground water level to serve as a neutral zone.
