Apply now for Public Board Member, Congressional District 7

Opportunity for public comment on fish kills protocol

The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) <u>released a statewide, multi-agency protocol</u> that clearly shows how agencies work together when investigating fish kills in Minnesota. The new guidance includes investigation process, communications expectations, and strategies for reducing fish kills. The MPCA seeks public comment on this draft protocol. In 2023, the Minnesota Legislature passed a law mandating the development of a fish kill response protocol. A fish kill is the unexpected, sudden death of large numbers of fish in a certain area. The fish kills addressed in the new protocol include those related to the discharge or runoff of pollutants from the land through incidents like toxic spills; runoff of manure, pesticides, or fertilizers; and high-temperature wastewater or stormwater discharges.

The public comment period begins March 11 and ends May 10. Members of the public are invited to review the draft protocol and submit comments by visiting the public comment page or by U.S. mail to: Minnesota Pollution Control Agency c/o Justin Watkins, 7381 Airport View Drive, Rochester, MN 55902. Deadline for public comment, May 10th.

Notice title: Sherco Solar 3 Environmental Assessment Availability

Notice description: The Minnesota Department of Commerce (Department) issued an environmental assessment (EA) for the project on April 22, 2024. The purpose of the EA is to provide information on the potential human and environmental impacts of the proposed project, possible mitigations for identified impacts, and evaluation of any alternatives contained in the scoping decision.

Project description: Xcel Energy has applied to the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission for a site permit, to construct Sherco Solar 3, an up to 250 MW solar energy generating system to be located in Sherburne County, Minnesota. Xcel Energy proposes to locate the project on approximately 1,780 acres between U.S. Highway 10 and the Mississippi River in the city of Clear Lake and Clear Lake Township in Sherburne County, Minnesota.
