

Updated EAW Climate Guidance

We are happy to announce that an updated 2023 EAW Climate Guidance is now posted on EQB's webpage. The purpose of this section of the guidance is to help project proposers and responsible governmental units as they develop climate-related information on the Environmental Assessment Worksheet, specifically in response to item 18. This guidance section should serve as a starting point for information to help answer item 18 of the EAW form, but it does not limit the use of other reliable and relevant tools for quantifying and assessing emissions. EQB will periodically update this guidance.

Project description: The Haviland Fields development is located on an approximately 35-acre site at 14501 Nowthen Blvd NW, Ramsey MN. The proposed project will include 22 townhouse units and 3 multifamily residential buildings with 476 total units. The development will also include stormwater management areas and preserved green space.

Merriam Junction Trail Project State Project 070-090-003

Location (city/township; county): Shakopee; Carver, Scott

Process: EAW

Project description: Scott County is proposing the Merriam Junction Trail Project (State Project (SP) 070-090-003), a multi-use bituminous trail that would utilize portions of the abandoned Union Pacific Railroad bed located between the Minnesota River Bluffs Regional Trail in the city of Carver (Carver County) to 145th St. W. in Scott County. The Project would include construction of one pedestrian bridge across the Minnesota River and three crossings over ravines. Other project elements include riverbank stabilization along portions of the Minnesota River.

Hermantown Business Park

Location (city/township; county): Hermantown; St. Louis

Process: Large AUAR

Step: Final order for review

Project description: The proposed maximum development scenario would construct a business park consisting of buildings with a combined area of up to 942,000 square feet. Project components include construction of commercial, warehouse/office buildings, parking areas, access roads, sanitary sewer and potable water services, and stormwater management ponds. Portions of the AUAR Study Area are currently used for light industrial, storage, and open space.
