Aerial Application of Herbicides

The MN Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry is planning to aerially apply herbicides on state forest lands in the Hibbing work area. Herbicide applications will occur on 336 acres on 6 individual sites. These applications will be used to prepare sites for tree planting and for the release of planted trees from competing vegetation. Aerial application will begin as early as August 10th and finish by September 15th, 2021. The herbicides, surfactants, and conditioners planned for use include: Roundup Pro Concentrate, Roundup Custom, Garlon XRT, Chopper, Oust, Liberate, Penetron, and Choice.
