Whetstone River Restoration Project

Location: Ortonville, Big Stone County, Minnesota and in Big Stone, Grant County, South Dakota
Process: Environmental assessment worksheet (EAW)
Step: EAW available
End of comment period: January 5, 2023

Project description: The Upper Minnesota River Watershed District is proposing hydrologic restoration efforts to reconnect the Whetstone River to the historic Whetstone River channel. A tributary of the Minnesota River, the Whetstone River is approximately 35 miles in length beginning in the Coteau des Prairies region of South Dakota. The historic Whetstone River channel flowed directly into the Minnesota River but is currently diverted into the Big Stone Lake just upstream of the Big Stone Lake Dam. The proposed project will restore the hydrologic connectivity of approximately 9,000 feet of the historic Whetstone River channel between the current Whetstone River and its confluence with the Minnesota River. The Whetstone River Restoration Project

will also reestablish the downstream floodplain and floodplain wetlands along the restored historic Whetstone River channel.

Adelmann Farm Industrial Park

Location: Lakeville, Dakota County Process: Alternative urban areawide review (AUAR) Step: Draft AUAR End of comment period: January 5, 2023

Project description: The AUAR study area encompasses an area totaling approximately 115.6 acres on two tax parcels in the City of Lakeville, entirely within Dakota County, Minnesota, the Adelmann Farm, shown on Figure 2. Formerly used as agricultural land in Eureka Township, the City of Lakeville annexed the study area in May 2021. Launch Properties is proposing to redevelop the study area to industrial uses. Redevelopment of the study area would include new infrastructure, including water service, sewer, stormwater, streets, and utilities, and most of the new services would be extensions to existing infrastructure or upgrading existing systems to support the new land uses.

Notice description: The Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) and Minnesota Department of Commerce (Department) will hold a public information and environmental assessment scoping meeting on the route permit application of Great River Energy (GRE) for its proposed transmission line rebuild project in Stearns County, Minnesota.
