EAW Comment Deadline: July 25, 2012

Project Title: High Island Dairy, LLC, Nicollet County

Description: High Island Dairy, LLC proposes to construct a 3,000 lactating Jersey cow dairy in Section 3, Lake Prairie Township, Nicollet County. The cows will be housed in a total confinement freestall barn with manure and wastewater collected and treated by an anaerobic digester. Le Sueur Cheese Company process wastewater and wastewater treatment sludge will be mixed with the manure and wastewater before discharge to the anaerobic digester. The biogas produced by the digester will be collected and used as fuel in a dual-fueled boiler to maintain the proper temperature of the waste in the anaerobic digester. The biogas may also be used in reciprocating engines to power electrical generators to provide electrical power to the site. The digested manure solids will be separated for use as bedding in the freestalls with the liquid fraction stored in a covered manure storage basin. The liquid manure and excess bedding solids will be land applied annually in the fall following crop harvest and used as fertilizer.
