Project Title: Al-Corn Clean Fuel Facility Expansion

Project Description: Al-Corn Clean Fuel (Al-Corn) proposes to expand its dry-mill ethanol production facility located in Claremont, Minnesota (Facility). Al-Corn is proposing to expand its Facility to increase ethanol production from 50 million gallons per year (MMGY) to 130 MMGY of 200-proof ethanol (Project). The Project will result in an increase of corn throughput to 47 million bushels per year (MMBu/year), and an increase in water appropriations by 200 MMGY, which will result in a total water appropriation of 400 MMGY.
