EIS Need Decision - POSITIVE DECLARATION

Scott County, Merriam Junction Sands, June 3, 2014 (April 14, 2014) -Merriam Junction Sands has revised their February 20, 2012, proposal to mine 982 acres, which had been previously noticed in the EQB Monitor. Merriam Junction Sands is now proposing to develop approximately 682 acres of land in Louisville Township, Scott County for nonmetallic mineral mining, including silica sand and processing operations. Mining and processing operations include: stripping, blasting, dewatering, extraction, washing, drying, screening, rail load out and phased reclamation. The following Scoping EAW is a redefinition of their earlier proposed mining and reclamation project and a previously published Scoping EAW. This Project was initially proposed to include land owned by three individual property owners but has been redefined to include land owned by only two individual property owners, with the third property owner no longer involved in the Project.) The Scoping EAW and Draft Scoping Decision Document for Merriam Junction Sands Mining and Processing Facility are now available for the 30 day scoping period. REVISED Final EIS Available

Project Title: Jordan Aggregates, LLC Project

Project Description: Jordan Aggregates, LLC proposes to mine 84.7 acres to a depth of 120 feet below the ground water into an alluvial sand and gravel aquifer, on property located at 17825 Valley View Drive in Sand Creek Township, Scott County, Minnesota. A 36 acre open water expression of the aquifer within the floodplain of Sand Creek will remain exposed to

periodic flood incursion.

The FEIS was determined inadequate on January 21, 2014, by the Scott County Board of Commissioners. This decision was based on the comments received by State agencies that an acceptable ground water monitoring and mitigation plan must be prepared as a part of the FEIS. The FEIS has been revised and a ground water monitoring and mitigation plan was prepared by the RGU in collaboration with State agencies and neighboring jurisdictions.

Interested persons may submit written comments on the adequacy of the revised Final EIS and ground water monitoring and mitigation plan for a period of 10 business days. The public comment period regarding the adequacy of Final EIS will end Monday July 7th, 2014.

Scott County, as required under 4410.2700 Subp. 3, will distribute copies of the Final EIS on June 23, 2014, to all persons that received the Draft EIS or submitted substantive comments on the draft EIS. The FEIS will also be available on the County's Website. Scott County will prepare and publish a press release for publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Scott County.

The Final EIS will be publicly distributed, and then brought to the Scott County Board of Commissioners for a decision on the adequacy of the FEIS.
