Sediment Reduction Strategy for the Minnesota River Basin and South Metro Mississippi River

Project description: The Sediment Reduction Strategy relates to the forthcoming Total Maximum Daily Load reports for sediment in the Minnesota River Basin and South Metro Mississippi River. The strategy provides interim sediment reduction targets and identifies highlevel actions that will lead to sediment reduction goals. The interim targets include a 25 percent reduction in total suspended solids by 2020 and a 50 percent reduction by 2030. Some of the actions include decreasing flow in rivers, retaining more water on the landscape and increasing living cover. Representatives of other agencies and organizations provided input as the strategy was developed.

Comment period: The draft strategy will be available for public review and comment through April 17, 2014.

- The hearing will last until everyone has the opportunity to offer comments or ask questions.

Project Description: Odell proposes to build a 200 megawatt (MW) Large Wind Energy Conversion System (LWECS).

- The proposed Odell Wind Farm will consist of 100 to 133 turbines, depending on the turbine model selected.
- Currently, 1.5 MW, 1.6 MW, and 2.0 MW turbine models are under consideration.
- Odell's goal is to complete construction and begin operation prior to December 31, 2014
- The proposed project is located in Lakeside and Mountain Lake Townships in Cottonwood County, Christiania and Kimball Townships in Jackson County, Cedar Township in Martin County, and Odin Township in Watonwan County, near Mountain Lake, Minnesota
- The proposed Odell Wind Farm will require an associated 115 kV transmission line and a 345/115kV substation. Odell filed a separate route plan permit application for the transmission facilities in Docket No. IP6914/TL-13-591.
- The proposed Odell Wind Farm will consist of 100 to 133 turbines, depending on the turbine model selected.
- · Currently, 1.5 MW, 1.6 MW, and 2.0 MW turbine models are under consideration.
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- The proposed Odell Wind Farm will require an associated 115 kV transmission line and a 345/115kV substation. Odell filed a separate route plan permit application for the transmission facilities in Docket No. IP6914/TL-13-591.

Process Information: Before the project can be built, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) must approve a site permit. The Commission accepted Odell's site permit application in November 2013. The Commission's decision-making process takes about six months.

On March 6, 2014, the Commission voted to approve a draft site permit for this project. An electronic copy of the draft site permit can be viewed on the Commission's and DOC's websites as described below. Comments about the draft site permit may be submitted now through April 17, 2014.

Any person may request a contested case hearing on the site permit proceeding for the Odell Wind Project pursuant to Minnesota Rule 7854.0900. All contested case hearing requests must be filed in writing with the ALJ by 4:30 p.m. on April 17, 2014.

Judge Neilson will use all the information in the record, including written comments and comments received at the public hearings, to write a report for the Commission. The report will include findings, conclusions, and recommendations about this project. After receiving the Judge's report, the Commission will schedule a meeting to make a final decision on this project, expected by May 2014.
