Project Title: Minnesota Valley Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Area, Renville County, Minnesota

Comment Deadline: May 10, 2017

Project Description: Renville County proposes the Minnesota Valley OHVRA on 278 acres of land in Sacred Heart (South) Township. Current sand and gravel mining will be phased out over 20 years, with reclamation including construction of proposed trails and amenities, and revegetation of remaining mined areas to prairie grassland species.

The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (MNDNR) will accept written comments on the Environmental Assessment Worksheet during the public review and comment period, which concludes on Wednesday, May 10, 2017, at 4:30 p.m.

Project Title: PLACE St. Louis Park

Project Description: The City of St. Louis Park has released an Environmental Assessment Worksheet (EAW) for the proposed PLACE St. Louis Park redevelopment. The development is located in St. Louis Park, Minn., at the southeast corner of Trunk Highway 7 and Wooddale Avenue South. PLACE, a 501(c)(3), proposes to redevelop nine brownfield parcels into a mixed-use, environmentally sustainable, transit-oriented community. The project will include 299 mixed-income living spaces, including live/work space for artists; a 110-room hotel; retail space; and neighborhood amenities like an urban forest. The project also includes an e-generation facility that will digest all compostable materials generated on-site.

The City of St. Louis Park is the Responsible Government Unit (RGU) for review of the mandatory Environmental Assessment Worksheet (EAW). The St. Louis Park City Manager approved the EAW for distribution on February 27, 2017. The deadline for written comments has been extended by two weeks and must be received by 4 p.m., Wednesday, April 19, 2017.
