Applications are currently open for Environmental Quality Board Member Positions in Congressional Districts 4 and 5

Applications are currently open for two Public Board Member positions: one each representing the public from Minnesota's Congressional Districts 4 and 5 (CD4 and CD5). CD4 includes part of Washington County and most of Ramsey County, including Saint Paul; and CD5 includes parts of Anoka and Hennepin Counties including Minneapolis. The positions are for a four-year term and are open until filled.

Serving on the <u>Environmental Quality Board</u> is a unique opportunity to shape environmental issues in Minnesota. Public members of the Board help bring the voices of Minnesotans from around the state into decision making, prompting our government to think in new ways about environmental challenges and solutions.



In the Matter of the Application of Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership for a Certificate of Need for the Proposed Line 3 Replacement Project in Minnesota from the North Dakota Border to the Wisconsin Border.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Minn. R. 4410.2800, subp. 6, that the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission, in an order issued on May 1, 2020, found the December 9, 2019 Second Revised Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Enbridge Line 3 Replacement Project to be adequate under Minn. R. 4410.2800, subp. 4. The Commission's May 1, 2020 Order Finding Environmental Impact Statement Adequate, Granting Certificate of Need as Modified, and Granting Routing Permit as Modified (May 1 Order) was the subject of various petitions for reconsideration pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 216B.27. The Commission issued an Order Denying Reconsideration of its May 1 Order on July 20, 2020.

The Commission's May 1 and July 20, 2020 orders, the Second Revised Final EIS, and other documents are available for viewing on the Commission's eDocket System at: mn.gov/puc, select eDockets, enter the year (14) and the docket number (916), or the year (15) and the

docket number (137), and select Search. The Second Revised Final EIS can also be viewed on the Department of Commerce Website at: mn.gov/commerce/energyfacilities/line3.
