Project Title: Upper Post Flats Affordable Housing, Fort Snelling State Park

Project Comment Deadline: September 25, 2019

Project Description: The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is proposing to lease the Upper Post in Fort Snelling State Park for 99 years to Fort Snelling Leased Housing Associates I, LLLP, an affiliate of Dominium Development & Acquisition, LLC, for rehabilitation into rental housing. Up to 215 housing units would be constructed within the existing footprints of 26 historic buildings. New construction to support the housing units would include a commons area with outdoor swimming pool, sidewalks, landscaping, parking facilities, new streets, stormwater infiltration basins, utility improvements, and reconstruction of existing streets and driveways. The DNR will accept written and electronic comments on the Environmental Assessment Worksheet during the public review and comment period, which concludes on Wednesday, September 25, 2019, at 4:30 p.m. Electronic or email comments may be sent to environmentalrev.dnr@state.mn.us with "Upper Post Flats" in the subject line.
