On December 14, 2017, the Commission issued an order that found the Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the proposed Line 3 Replacement Project to be inadequate under Minn. R. 4410.2800. In that order, the Commission identified four specific deficiencies in the Final EIS that must be remedied before it can be considered adequate.

In accordance with the Commission's December 14 Order, the Minnesota Department of Commerce issued the revised Final EIS for the Line 3 Replacement Project on February 12, 2018.

WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD

Comment Period: Comments on the revised Final EIS will be accepted through **4:30** p.m., Tuesday, February **27**, **2018**. Comments received after the comment period closes may not be considered.

Topics Open for Comment: The Commission is accepting comments only on whether the revised Final EIS adequately addresses the four specific deficiencies identified in its December 14, 2017 Order:

- Does the revised Final EIS include additional information to: (i) indicate how far and where SA-04 would need to be moved to avoid the karst topography it would otherwise traverse, and (ii) provide a revised environmental impact analysis of SA-04 that specifically reflects the resulting relocation of that alternative?
- Does the revised Final EIS clarify that quantitative representations of route and system alternatives impacts do not necessarily reflect the actual qualitative impacts of those alternatives?
- Does the revised Final EIS identify the extent to which resource impacts of route alternatives in the existing Line 3 corridor are or are not additive, *i.e.*, to what extent does a route alternative introduce new or additional impacts beyond the impacts of the existing pipelines in that corridor?
- Does the revised Final EIS clarify that a traditional cultural properties survey must be completed before the start of any construction pursuant to any permit granted in this proceeding?
