# Project Title: County State Aid Highway 70 Expansion Project

Comment Deadline: February 12, 2020

**Project Description:** Dakota County is proposing to expand County State Aid Highway 70 (referred to in document as CSAH 70) from Kenrick Avenue/Kensington Boulevard to County State Aid Highway (CSAH 23) (Cedar Ave), to a four-lane divided highway. Improvements include two traffic lanes in each direction with a center median, the addition of turn lanes, access modifications, and a trail on both sides of CSAH 70.
