**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the Minnesota Department of Commerce, Energy Environmental Review and Analysis (EERA) announces the release of the environmental assessment (EA) for the proposed Detroit Lakes Public Utility 115 kV Transmission Line and Substation.

The Environmental Assessment is a written document that describes the human and environmental impacts of the transmission line project (and selected alternative routes) and methods to mitigate such impacts. Applications for high voltage transmission line route permits under the alternative permitting process require a public hearing upon completion of the EA pursuant to Minn. R. 7850.3800.

The public hearing will be noticed separately and in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 216E.03, subdivision 6.
