Project Title: Interstate Island Avian Habitat Restoration Project

Comment Deadline: December 26, 2019

Project Description: Minnesota DNR proposes to restore and protect imperiled avian habitat on Interstate Island Wildlife Management Area (WMA). The WMA is the largest of two remaining Common Tern nesting areas in the Lake Superior watershed and is the only federally-listed critical habitat for Piping Plover in Minnesota. Recent high water levels have caused significant loss of critical habitat on the island.

Project Description: BASF Corporation filed a Notification for Release of a Genetically Engineered Organism with the Minnesota Department of Agriculture, MDA notification number 19-NO-41. Notification is for genetically modified WHEAT, pending USDA-APHIS Biotechnology Regulatory Services (BRS) approval for the environmental release of transgenic wheat, referenced as Application Number 19-270-101rm.

The counties identified for release include the following: Clay-2 locations with 50 acres per location. Project categories include AP (Agronomic Performance) and HT (Herbicide Tolerance).
