# Notice of Permit Decision in the Matter of the Application of Minnesota Power for the Mesaba Junction 115 kV Transmission Line and Associated Facilities in the City of Hoyt Lakes

**Project Description:** In a resolution approved on September 9, 2019 the City of Hoyt Lakes City Council determined that the environmental assessment adequately addressed potential environmental effects of the Mesaba Junction 115 kV transmission line project and issued a conditional use permit to Minnesota Power. The permit authorizes construction of approximately 5.4 miles of new 115 kV line along the existing Laskin-Hoyt Lakes transmission line corridor.

The City of Hoyt Lakes conducted a local review and permit process as is allowed under Minnesota Statutes Chapter 216-E.05. The City conducted a public hearing on August 20, 2019 and accepted written comments until September 3, 2019. The only comments received were included in a letter from the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency dated September 3, 2019, requesting that the City note that Section 401 Water Quality Certification may be required and identifying a mis-labeled creek name in the document.
