### **Environmental Impact Statement Need Decisions**

The noted responsible governmental unit has determined the following project does not require preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). ## Project Title: Fargo-Moorhead Flood Risk Management Project

**Project Description:** The proposed Project would create a 30-mile long diversion channel on the west side of the Fargo-Moorhead urban area. Two control structures (i.e., dams) with tieback embankments would span the Wild Rice River (North Dakota) and Red River (North Dakota and Minnesota). An upstream area would be used as a staging (or flood storage) area. During high flows, a portion of the flow from upstream rivers and streams would be routed through the diversion channel, reducing peak flows through Fargo- Moorhead. The two control structures would be operated when needed to store additional water in the staging area, thereby further reducing peak flows through the metro. Water in the staging would be released later, as flows decline.

The Project requires construction of a Class I dam, the Red River dam. The Red River is bordered by both North Dakota and Minnesota. In Minnesota, there is a Mandatory EIS for Class I Dams (MN Rules part 4410.4400, subpart 18). The rule designates the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (MNDNR) as the Responsible Governmental Unit (RGU) for environmental review (an EIS) of this Project.

The MDNR will accept written comments on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) during the public review and comment period, which begins on September 14, 2015 and will end October 28, 2015.

# Project Title: Interstate 35E MnPASS Extension Project

**Project Description:** The Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) is proposing a project in the cities of Lino Lake, White Bear Township, White Bear Lake, Vadnais Heights and Little Canada to extend the MnPASS Lane from Highway 36 to County Road J. The scope of the project is to construct a new MnPASS lane in the northbound direction from County Road 96 to County Road J by converting the inside grass median to an additional lane. A wide shoulder for both northbound and southbound I-35E, currently under construction with the Goose Lake Road Bridge Project, will be repurposed into a MnPASS Lane between County Road 96 and County Road E. The existing inside southbound lane on I-35E will be restriped to

a MnPASS Lane from County Road E to Highway 36. The project is also proposing eight noise barriers and a water quality system. The Environmental Assessment (EA) describes the proposed project, impacts, and mitigation.
