Project Title: County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 18 Realignment Project, Nisswa, Crow Wing County Minnesota (SP018-618-009)

Description: The proposed project will realign CSAH 18 which is currently aligned through the City of Nisswa Downtown area. The new CSAH 18 corridor will be constructed from TH 371 (approximately 1250 feet south of the interim traffic lights on the existing CSAH 18 connection) to the existing CSAH 18 at Twinleaf Circle.

Location: The Public Hearing for the project will be held on Wednesday, March 9th, 2011 from 4 to 6 p.m. at the Nisswa City Hall, PO Box 410, Nisswa, MN 56468.

The Public Hearing will provide an opportunity for the public to comment on the proposed project and answer any questions. Maps, drawings, and other pertinent information, including the EA/EAW, will be available. The public is encouraged to attend the Public Hearing to comment and submit verbal comments on the EA/EAW document that will become part of the official public hearing record. The public is also encouraged to provide written comments on the document to the County Highway Department through **March 24th, 2011**. All comments will be incorporated and responded to in the final EA/EAW.
