Pelican Bay Addition Residential Development

Location: Lake Sarah Township, Murray County Process: Environmental assessment worksheet (EAW) Step: EAW available End of comment period: February 16, 2023

Project description: Rupp Construction is proposing a residential development on a 34acre project site. The Pelican Bay Addition project will develop 29 residential lakeshore lots along the shoreline of Lake Shetek in Murray County, Minnesota. The first phase of construction will include limited grading and site preparation for selling individual lots and construction of the residential road on the project site. Construction will also include development of attendant features for the development including the improvement of an existing private field road to a new public access road and installation of utilities to serve the development, including sanitary sewer connection and a new community well. The project is located within the 1,000 ft Shoreland Overlay District of Lake Shetek.

Application of Hayward Solar LLC for a CN & Site Permit for a Solar Project in Freeborn County

Location: Hayward, Freeborn County Process: Alternative review

Notice title: Public Utilities Commission - Notice of Decision on the Hayward Solar Project

Notice description: In the Matter of the Application of Hayward Solar LLC for a Certificate of Need and Site Permit for the up to 150 MW Hayward Solar Project in Freeborn County, Minnesota – Public Utilities Commission Docket Nos. IP-7053/CN-21-112, and IP-7053/GS-21-113 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in an order issued on November 30, 2022, the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission: (1) found that the environmental assessment prepared by the Department of Commerce and the record created at the public hearing addressed the issues identified in the scoping decision; (2) granted a certificate of need; and 3) issued a site permit to Hayward Solar LLC for its up to 150-megawatt solar energy generating system, a 3-4.5 mile 345 kilovolt overhead transmission line, and associated facilities located in Freeborn County, Minnesota. **Project description:** Hayward Solar LLC is authorized to construct and operate an up to 150-megawatt solar energy generating system and associated facilities in Freeborn County.
