Project Description: The Cates Family owns three parcels of approximately 68.9 acres of agricultural land located north of Highway 55 at Chippewa Road and Willow Drive in Medina. There is an existing farmstead and associated structures on the site. The proposed project consists of a total of approximately 664,500 square feet of office/warehouse uses on the site. Development would include new infrastructure, including water service, sewer, stormwater, streets, and utilities. All of these new services would be extensions to existing infrastructure or upgrading existing systems to support the new land development.

Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant Additional Dry Cask Storage

Location: Monticello, Wright County
Process: Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)
Step: EIS Scoping EAW and Draft Scoping Decision
End of Comment Period: February 9, 2022
Project Description: The Monticello nuclear generating plant (MNGP) is a 671

megawatt electric generating plant in Monticello, Minn. Spent nuclear fuel from the plant is stored on site in the MNGP ISFSI. Xcel Energy proposes to extend the operating life of the MNGP to 2040. To accommodate the additional spent nuclear fuel associated with this extension, Xcel Energy proposes to expand storage within the MNGP ISFSI. This additional storage requires installation of a second concrete support pad within the existing ISFSI. Additionally, a modular concrete storage system will be placed on the new concrete pad. Xcel Energy indicates that spent fuel will be stored in welded canisters; approximately 14 additional spent fuel storage canisters will be needed for operations through 2040.

A public comment period will extend past the meeting dates to allow for written comments. Department of Commerce staff will preside over the meeting. Department staff, as well as staff from Xcel Energy, will be available to answer questions about the environmental review process and the project. Meetings will conclude after everyone who wishes to offer comments has had an opportunity to speak.
