Cambridge 2 Fuel Conversion

Project description: The project would replace existing natural gas burners with dualfuel burners and install associated facilities to allow ULSD fuel oil combustion during periods of natural gas curtailment. The project is expected to protect GRE customers from extremely high energy prices. The project is located within GRE's existing Cambridge Station at 2438 349th Avenue NE; Cambridge, MN.

Project description: HAS Capital Advisors, LLC is proposing to construct a residential development on 82.7 acres in Owatonna, MN. The Project includes 324 residential units: 162 single-family detached, 24 single-family attached, 66 townhouses and 72 multi-family. Construction will also include internal roadways, stormwater infrastructure, and utilities.

Beaumont Bluffs Residential Development

Location (city/township; county): Jordan; Scott Process: EAW Step: EIS need decision

Project description: The City of Jordan invites the public to review and comment on the Supplemental EAW regarding the Beaumont Bluffs development project. The project is proposed on 232.3 acres on the southwest side of the City of Jordan and consists of a mix of twin homes, villas, single-family residences, and open space. About 123.6 acres will remain undeveloped, including approximately 80 acres owned by the city. On January 18, 2022, the City Council voted to approve the declaration that no EIS was needed for the Beaumont Bluffs preliminary plat application. However, Dba JMH Beaumont Bluffs LLC is requesting to amend the EAW to allow for the removal and export of 100,000-125,000 cubic yards of soil, described as medium-to-fine-grained sand, for foundation and roadway construction projects. The proposal to remove soil off-site was not included in the original EAW and therefore a Supplemental EAW is needed for additional environmental review.

Rosemount Industrial

Location (city/township; county): Rosemount; Dakota Process: Large AUAR Step: Draft AUAR End of comment period: August 17, 2023

Project description: The AUAR study area encompasses an area totaling approximately 235 acres on 12 parcels in the City of Rosemount, Dakota County, Minnesota. Scannell Properties, LLC is proposing to redevelop the study area from existing agriculture to business park uses. One scenario is proposed for evaluation in the AUAR and includes multiple buildings for a total of 1.92 million square feet of proposed industrial development. The proposed development within the AUAR study area is anticipated to start Fall 2023.

Project description: Xcel Energy and the City of Northfield are partnering to conduct an Alternative Urban Areawide Review (AUAR) for an approximately 787-acre area in the northwestern portion of the City of Northfield. Portions of the AUAR area include land within Greenvale Township. Two development scenarios will be evaluated as part of the AUAR which primarily consist of technology center and industrial park uses.
