The project includes the construction of approximately 208 single-family residential units and is located on the south side of Dale Road near the intersection of Dale Road and Woodbury Drive (CSAH 19). The project will include a roadway network, stormwater infrastructure, and the installation of municipal sewer and water systems.

Project Description: The City of Bloomington proposes to complete a maintenance project to restore the hydraulic capacity and remove accumulated sediment within Oxboro Lake. The project will involve sediment removal, culvert reconstruction and some shoreline stabilization and restoration. The project will improve the lake's functionality and water quality while improving the quality of the water leaving lake and flowing into Nine Mile Creek.
