Brooklyn Park Gateway AUAR Update

Project Description: The Brooklyn Park Gateway Alternative Urban Areawide Review (AUAR) examines 125.0 acres of land in Brooklyn Park to analyze the impacts and mitigation measures necessary to accommodate a mixed-use development. The city of Brooklyn Park adopted the Brooklyn Park Gateway Final AUAR and Mitigation Plan on January 26, 2016. The AUAR included analysis of two (2) development scenarios. Since the adoption of the Brooklyn Park Gateway AUAR in 2016, the development scenarios have changed and the 610 Junction development in the northwest corner of the study area has begun but the study boundaries for this AUAR Update remain the same. The analysis of this AUAR Update is based on two (2) new scenarios outlined in section 2.1. The City of Brooklyn Park as the Responsible Government Unit (RGU) has determined that the two (2) scenarios are feasible for this site.
