Project description: The Nine Mile Creek Watershed District proposes to conduct a stream restoration project at two locations (Eden Prairie & Bloomington) to address bank erosion and degraded instream habitat to restore the ecological and hydraulic functions of the creek. The project will include reconnecting the creek with the floodplain, installing grade control structures to limit channel incision, installing tree trunks and rootwads for instream habitat, and establishing native riparian vegetation.
