Montrose AUAR Update

Location: Montrose, Wright County Process: Alternative urban areawide review (AUAR) update Step: AUAR update available End of comment period: May 16, 2023

Project description: The Montrose AUAR study area consists of approximately 5,300 developable acres surrounding the City of Montrose. It is proposed to include low, medium, and high-density residential, industrial, and commercial development. The project includes construction of roads, homes, businesses, trails, parks, ponds, and utilities such as storm water, wastewater, and water supply piping. This AUAR also analyzes the impacts of approximately 1,700 acres of development that exists or is in a various stage of approval and 100 acres of railroad right-of-way, for a total analysis area of approximately 7,100 acres. Pursuant to Minnesota Rules, part 4410.3610, subpart 7, regardless of any significant changes an AUAR and plan for mitigation must be revised every five years until all development in the study area has received final approval. This report serves as an update to the previous AUAR Update, which was published in 2018.

Project description: Lake Wilson Solar submitted applications to the Public Utilities Commission for a certificate of need and a site permit to construct an up to 150megawatt solar farm with associated battery storage in Chanarambie and Leeds Townships, Murray County, Minnesota. The Public Utilities Commission and Department of Commerce are holding public information and environmental assessment scoping meetings for the proposed project.
